## OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH IN THE PYROTECHNICS INDUSTRY

Pursuant to the mandate of the Department to ensure a safe and healthful workplace for all workers, all establishments engaged in the manufacture, distribution, and sale of pyrotechnics are hereby reminded to strictly comply with Occupational Safety and Health Standards under Republic Act No. 11058,¹ Department Order No. 198, Series of 2018,² Department Order No. 134, Series of 2014,³ and other related issuances.

In coordination with the Bureau of Fire Protection, Philippine National Police, and Local Government Units, all Regional Directors are hereby directed to monitor establishments' compliance with the aforementioned and other related issuances to prevent workplace accidents under Department Order No. 238, Series of 2023. They shall submit the list of establishments monitored to the Bureau of Working Conditions on or before 10 January 2025.

Be guided accordingly.
